I wish this book had been available when I was a student. The translations are clear and the commentary very useful. My researcher heart loves the English, followed by the Pinyin, then the Chinese characters and ending with the commentary. I bought the original version years ago and just plain could not puzzle out what the translations really meant, so I am very happy with this edition.

To build solid clinical thinking we need a solid foundation. The "statements of facts" are the blocks needed to put that foundation together.

This version is a wonderful resource for students and a very good review of theory for established practitioners.
